WHY MAKE A WILL?

Making a Will ensures your wishes are carried out after your death.

The best time to make your Will is NOW, when you can think through the whole question of organising your affairs so that loved ones will be spared as much anxiety as possible.

Financial provision can be made for family and friends, instructions for funeral arrangements, and gifts to Charities of your choice.

All gifts to Charities are tax-free.

As circumstances change you can review and alter your Will at any time.

WHAT IF I DON'T?

Failure to make a Will can leave your dependants with a whole lot of unnecessary problems.

The Law of Intestacy often results in your estate being distributed in a way you would not have chosen.

The taxman will take 40% of your estate over £312,000 - 2008/2009-tax year.

A word of warning, home made Wills often cause problems; ensure they are legal.

WHY EXETER ICE?

ICE was established by a partnership of churches within Exeter and has dedicated itself to bringing a Christian dimension into Exeter's education system.

- It is a Registered Charity, a Company Limited by Guarantee and is administered by a Board of Directors made up of local church leaders, educationalists and parents.
- It is an associate ministry of Youth for Christ-England.
- It is funded by voluntary donations from individuals, churches, fund raising events, local businesses and Trusts.
- Its staff and associates are signatories to the Evangelical Alliance Statement of Faith, one of the most widely recognised and accepted formulations of Christian belief in use in Britain today.
